**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: The Maha Metro Nagpur Marathon- Publicity of Sabka Vishwas  
Legacy Dispute Resolution Scheme- reg.**

The Maha Metro Nagpur has informed that they would be organising the 5<sup>th</sup> edition of Nagpur Marathon on Sunday, the 1<sup>st</sup> of December, 2019. They are promoting social cases like 'Donate Organ- Save Life' and 'Run for Tobacco Free Nagpur'. A total of about 8,000 runners are expected to participate in the marathon from across the length and breadth of the country. The marathon has four categories i.e. 5 km walk, 10 km endurance run, 21 km half marathon and 42 km full marathon.

The Nagpur-II GST Commissionerate has decided to tie up with the Maha Metro Nagpur Marathon **to provide publicity to the Sabka Vishwas Legacy Dispute Resolution Scheme (SVLDRS), 2019.** As a part of the same, the Commissionerate would be setting up a stall there and shall distribute pamphlets/ leaflets in order to publicize the SVLDRS. Further we will also distribute 500 T-shirts printed with SVLDRS matter so that the SVLDRS gets due publicity.

Since the Commissionerate is associating itself with the Marathon, the **organizers of the Marathon have offered special discounted entry fee for the employees of the CGST and their families as below:**
